

Grayson County Board of Supervisors  
VDOT Hearing  
May 26, 2009

Members attending this meeting were: Larry Bartlett, Doug Carrico, Mike Maynard, and Brenda Sutherland. Joe Vaughan was absent.

Matthew Cox, VDOT Representative, presented the Six Year Plan and Construction Budget. The public hearing was opened at 5:05 pm.

Public Comments were as follows: citizen – Chestnut Grove Road – one way bridge, pot holes. Flat Ridge Road to Fox Creek Road – no lines for a couple of miles. River Bend Road – needs improvements with the canoe rental.

Larry Bartlett moved to close the public hearing, duly seconded by Doug Carrico. Motion carried 4-0.

IN RE: SIX YEAR PLAN

The Grayson County Board of Supervisors adopted the following resolution on motion of Larry Bartlett, duly seconded by Doug Carrico. Motion carried 4-0.

Whereas, Sections 33.1-23 and 33.1-23.4 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended provides the opportunity for each county to work with the Virginia Department of Transportation in developing a Secondary Six-Year Road Plan,

Whereas, this Board had previously agreed to assist in the preparation of this Plan, in accordance with the Virginia Department of Transportation policies and through (2014/15) as well as the Construction Priority List (2009/10) on May 25, 2009, after duly advertised so that all citizens of the County had the opportunity to participate in said hearing and to make comments and recommendations concerning the propose Plan and Priority List,

Whereas, Matthew B. Cox, Residency Administrator, Virginia Department of Transportation, appeared before the Board and recommended approval of the Six- Year Plan for Secondary Roads (2009/10 through 2014/15) and the Construction Priority List (2009/10) for Grayson County,

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved that since said Plan appears to be in the best interests of the Secondary Road System, said Secondary Six- Year Plan (2009/10 through 2014/15) and Construction Priority List (2009/10) are hereby approved as presented at the public hearing.

The Board of Supervisors also adopted the following resolution regarding the Six Year Plan on motion of Doug Carrico, duly seconded by Brenda Sutherland. Motion carried 4-0.

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors of Grayson County, Virginia (“Board”) desires to consider that the following roads noted below are being displaced from the Fiscal Year 2009/10 Secondary Six Year Improvement Plan. The Board wishes to maintain a County Priority List in the order the roads are shown on the previously approved Fiscal Year 2008/09 Secondary Six Year Plan for any future state funds that may be designated for use in Grayson County as a part of any future Secondary Six Year Improvement Plan.
