Public Hearing
June 24, 2009

Members attending this meeting were: Joe Vaughan, Larry Bartlett, Brenda Sutherland, Mike Maynard, and Doug Carrico.

IN RE: PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing was held to receive comments regarding proposed changes to the Solid Waste Ordinance. The following people spoke:

- Ron Catron – concern with fees, fee structure wording – indexed to include number of bedrooms
- Scott Lamb – Healing Springs Mobile Home Park – concerns with fees going to landlord instead of household. He has 30 units (2 units empty). He is also concerned with how the fees for bins get collected.
- Evelyn Hughes – has a vacant lot – Will she be charged \$3 per week? Is revenue going into the General Fund or strictly for garbage pick up? Can citizens see the fund account?
- John Anderson - \$8,288 - \$124 for residents 260,000 plus
- Wilton Dolinger – Take a look at spending. Cut 3-5% in each department.
- Daniel Cannoy – Budget comparison
- Joe Cook – is not a resident but owns property. Thinks the garbage pick up is already being paid for. How many people are paying for garbage pick up? His lot is vacant. Get industry in the County!
- Robert Nichols – Already paid for garbage collection. Why pay again?
- Aaron Criner (for Frank Ceary) – Concerned with multi-dwelling fees.
- Susan Shaw-Snow – Tenant of Frank Ceary's. Rent will have to be increased.
- Dotti Philpott – Senior Citizen – Pay one month at a time vs. six months at a time.
- Melissa Combs – Property is owned by her mother who doesn't live there. Will she be charged?
- Ned Shupe – Way to get 1.1 on short fall.
- Mr. McClure – Went through budget items asking why some couldn't be cut.
- Wayne Hash – Owns 10 houses. How does he pay?
- Ms. Delp – Consider the people that pick up trash. Her husband picks up trash.
- Fred Weatherman – Why not add 2 or 3 cents on the tax levy?
- Jennifer Snow – Consider reducing budget. Do not charge us more.
- Sandra Anders – Single mom with 2 kids. Can't pay any more.
- Brenda Anders – Lifelong resident 41 years. Lost jobs.
