Resolution

Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the Commonwealth of Virginia's Department of Emergency Management, and the Mount Rogers Planning District Commission agree that a regional Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan shall be developed for the Mount Rogers Planning District; and

WHEREAS, the Mount Rogers Planning District Commission has completed the necessary tasks required by the agreement between the Virginia's Department of Emergency Management and the Mount Rogers Planning District Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan contains risk assessments and potential losses of each of the identified hazards, a mitigation strategy to reduce or eliminate the risk of damage from future incidents, and a process to update the plan every five (5) years, thereby making Grayson County, Virginia, a jurisdiction of the Mount Rogers Planning District, eligible for hazard mitigation grant assistance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Grayson County Board of Supervisors adopts the Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation Plan for Grayson County, Virginia.
