IN RE: CONSENT AGENDA

Brenda Sutherland made the motion to approve the agenda/consent agenda; duly seconded by David M. Sexton. Motion carried 5-0.

IN RE: REPORTS, PRESENTATIONS OR REQUEST(S)

IN RE: OLD BUSINESS

IN RE: NEW BUSINESS – APPOINTMENTS

DISTRICT III – David M. Sexton made the motion to reappoint Brenda Sutherland for another one (1) year term along with Mary Young as an alternate for another one (1) year term (both terms expire December 31, 2014); duly seconded by Glen E. Rosenbaum. Motion carried 5-0.

MT. ROGERS ASAP - Bill Shaffner's term will expire on December 31, 2014. No action taken on this appointment.

PLANNING COMMISSION – David M. Sexton made the motion to reappoint Don Dudley for a four (4) year term whose current term will expire on December 31, 2014; duly seconded by Glen E. Rosenbaum. Motion carried 5-0.

NEW RIVER HIGHLANDS RC&D – Glen E. Rosenbaum made the motion to reappoint Elaine Holeyton for another one (1) year term; duly seconded by David M. Sexton. Motion carried 5-0.

IN RE: AUTHORIZE A PUBLIC HEARING FOR AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF GRAYSON COUNTY, VIRGINIA TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF GRAYSON COUNTY, VIRGINIA

Jonathan D. Sweet explained that most organizations have moved away from the "Industrial" Development Authority to the "Economic" Development Authority which better suites what the Grayson County Authority is trying to accomplish. In order to do this a public hearing must be held. Brenda Sutherland made the motion to approve a

public hearing to be held at the next Board of Supervisors meeting on November 13, 2014; duly seconded by David M. Sexton. Motion carried 5-0.

IN RE: COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN OPTION AND PROVIDER

Jonathan D. Sweet introduced Alan Bayes of Trustpoint Insurance. Mr. Bayes presented a power point presentation of requests/responses regarding the RFP. Jonathan D. Sweet then asked for the Board's confirmation to move forward toward a self-funded approach. Glen E. Rosenbaum made the motion to approve the move forward; duly seconded by Kenneth R. Belton. Motion carried 5-0.

IN RE: COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

Jonathan D. Sweet presented the following:

- In support of October being Breast Cancer Awareness Month, the courthouse is illuminating "pink lights" of a night.
- Rec Park improvements – the playground has been updated and \$1700 of mulch was donated for the playground by Blevins.
- Will begin annual review of our Comp Plan and priority objectives
- Mentioned that he had just returned from the VEDA Conference held in Richmond, Virginia and noted some of the recognition from our recent successes in economic development.

Mr. Sweet then noted that Mitch Smith has some notables:

- Tax tickets will go out by October 30, 2014
- Grayson County Photo Contest is going on now until January 15, 2015. Elaine Holeyton will be in charge of this contest – Top 10 photos will be awarded a cash prize of \$50.
- Grayson and Carroll Counties will assist Virginia Tourism Corporation in sponsoring "Tourism Marketing 101" on November 4 at 5:30 p.m.; "Tourism Marketing 102" on December 8 at 5:30 p.m.; "Tourism Marketing 103" on January 13, 2015 at 5:30 p.m.; and "Marketing Implementation for Professionals- Logo Presentation" on January 22, 2014. All classes will be held at the Crossroads Institute in Galax, Virginia. If interested call Grayson Tourism or Carroll Tourism.
- Round-the-Mountain workshop will be held October 23, 2014 in Grayson County.
- Pre-K through 2nd grade basketball sign-up is going on now through October 25, 2014 which will also be the last games of football.
- Jack Tolber, Regional VDEM, Haz-Mat Coordinator, will hold a Meth Awareness Class in November or December here in Grayson County. Contact Jimmy Moss, Grayson County Haz-Mat Officer for more details.

- Department of Social Services Fuel Assistance Program will begin on October 14, 2014.
- Erin Farmer Cox, Grayson County 4-H Director, is assisting Galax through one of their enrichment programs.
- Kevin Spurlin was involved again with the Annual Ag Field Day and there were approximately 250 kids that participated from Grayson County and Sparta, North Carolina.
- Patti Fields, of the Extension Office, continues to work with the local Health Department to assist our senior citizens nutritional needs.
- A Regional Forest-Wildlife Tour will be held on October 30, 2014. Contact Kevin Spurlin if interested in attending.
- With winter weather approaching, we have already begun to meet and ensure preparedness in many areas such as supplies, code updates, etc. We have also been in contact with Mr. Phil Hysell from NOAA Weather Center in Blacksburg, Virginia and will be scheduling a "SKYWARN" class on winter weather to be held here in Grayson County within the next couple of months. This class is also a requirement for our county to stay "storm ready".
