 Angela Biram – Sip & Taste - presented to the Authority and noted this would be a small café and part pub – explained what she has already contributed financially – will be a small café and pub – asking for \$75K with \$55K being key for equipment – and the \$20K for employees' salaries – hope to open the first of the year – hopes to have the liquor license by the first of the year as well. Mr. Butler noted that the Authority will discuss at the next meeting in November and ask Ms. Biram to attend the December meeting.

 Gold Hill Cidery – Mitchell Britt – showed the Authority his budget and explained about the grants that he's applying for should find out about whether the grant(s) have been awarded to us sometime in December. Discussion took place. Mr. Britt noted his goal is to have it built out around March or April 2024. Mr. Butler noted to Mr. Britt to continue working with Mrs. Young and keep her updated on his progress. Mr. Cannaday made the motion to approve \$50K to be used for the build-out and infrastructure needs; duly seconded by Mr. Warren. Motion carried. Mr. Boyer noted that staff will get with Mrs. Young and Mrs. Edwards to proceed.

- Grayson Garment Building Mr. Butler noted that he and Mr. Cannaday has spoken with Mr. Michael Sawer with RPM and Mr. Sawer would be willing to section off approximately 4,000 sq. feet for a possible child care facility (outfitting and providing the space). Discussion took place and consensus of the Authority is to continue considering this option.
- ARS Mr. Butler noted that we have \$200K to upgrade housing in Grayson County – Jimmy Moss and Aaron Sizemore is working with Grayson County on this
